

## COMMUNITY SURVEY PROGRAMME

February – early March 2006.

### *A Summary of progress to date.*

Since the commencement of the survey programme in August 2005, an area of approximately 16ha (38 acres) has been subject to earthwork survey at the scales of 1:1000 and 1:500). All survey has been carried out to the national standard established by RCHME (1999).

The results have exceeded initial expectations and have recorded features ranging in date from the later prehistoric period (probably Iron Age c800BC-AD43) to the post-Medieval.

To the east of the village, an area of probable later prehistoric fields has been recorded underlying cultivation remains of Medieval and later date (Fig. 1). Field observation suggests that traces of this early field system extends beyond the area surveyed and has influenced the layout and orientation of the present landscape.
